Quotation received without Earnest Money Deposit and cost of quotation schedule will be summarily rejected.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. The Treated water will be delivered from a filling point at the Sewage Treated Plant near Mandakini Hostel in IITM Campus from 6.00PM to 6.00AM.
2. As per the availability upto a maximum of 400 Kilo Litre of treated water will be sold per day.
3. The successful bidder will have to deposit the total cost of water for the 20 days at the accepted rates as advance in the form of DD drawn in favour of Registrar, IITM payable at Chennai / RTGS to the Institute Account (The details will be provided later). The advance amount will be adjusted towards the quantity supplied. Further water will be sold only after further remittance of the advance amount for another 20 days of supply.
4. The Quality of the treated water will meet the minimum standards as per the recommendations of the TNPCB norms. The treated water purchased from IIT Madras is to be used for secondary purposes only like flushing, gardening, AC Chiller units and construction activities etc., IITM will not be responsible for any violation of the clause by the purchaser of treated water.
5. Utmost care to be taken on the safety of the Campus residents. Vehicle movement shall be restricted from the entry gate (Mandakini hostel gate) to sewage treatment plant and back to the Mandakini gate. Penalty shall be imposed for the non-adherence of this rule and any other safety norms specified by IITM.
6. IITM Campus is an ecologically sensitive area with wildlife animals. Any incident by the bidder related to the wildlife will be dealt as per the wildlife act. IITM will not be responsible for in this regard.
7. The firm accepted for sale of treated water shall obtain necessary passes from the security section of IITM and confine their movement within the areas of their activity.
8. Quotation should accompany an E.M.D of rs 10000/- in the form of DD drawn in favour of Registrar, IIT Madras payable at Chennai, which shall be returned after completion of the contract. If the contractor intends to close the agreement at any stage, the EMD amount will be refunded immediately.
9. In respect of unsuccessful bidders, the EMD shall be returned immediately after the bid is finalized.

10. The Vehicles should not be parked near building or on road sides causing obstructions to traffic.
11. The collected treated water should be removed then and there.
12. The officer inviting quotations shall have the right of rejecting all or any of the quotations and will not be bound to accept the highest or any other quotation.
13. Four numbers bidders will be selected based on the based on the highest quote submitted by the bidders.
14. The highest rate offered by the bidder will be the salable rate for treated water by IITM. However if the other three bidders agrees for the highest rate fixed by IITM, they will also be issued the work order for a maximum 50 Kilo litre per day.
15. All efforts will be taken by IITM to supply the stipulated quantity of water. However IITM reserves the right to stop selling of water due to unforeseen reasons. The due amount if any will be refunded to the suppliers immediately.
