INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS

1.1. GENERAL

1.1.1 Specification No. DOE/2019/001/CMIS/VSUN

1.1.2 For and on behalf of the Centre for Industrial Consultancy and Sponsored Research (IC&SR), (CMIS) IIT Madras of sealed competitive bids under Two Cover system are invited as per the details furnished hereunder:

1.2 SCOPE OF WORK

1.2.1 The near-shore and offshore in-situ measurements at three south Indian coastal states namely, Tamil Nadu, Kerala and U.T. of Puducherry for the Implementation of Coastal Management Information System (CMIS) by Central Water Commission (CWC), Ministry of Water Resources (MoWR), Government of India is in progress through Department of Ocean Engineering (DOE) of IIT Madras from October 2016 onwards. The major field measurement involves along the South West (SW) & South East (SE) coast of India covering the complete monsoon and non-monsoon hydrodynamic measurements for the selected sites at each state. The measurements of tide, wave, current, bathymetry, Sea Bed Sediments and Seawater samplings are all can be carried out/achieved through the well experienced safe operations of the boats within the stipulated period. All these field data are mandatory for the numerical modellings as an input for the understandings and predictions of shoreline behaviors, extreme severe events (cyclone, tsunami, etc) behavior of shores and also for its protection and for better management. This CMIS project was successfully executed since its inception and further, it's now extended for the execution by DOE, IITM for One More Year (2019 to 2020).

1.3 EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD)

1.4 SUBMISSION OF TENDER:

However the tenderers shall indicate applicable taxes, GST and their rates at the time of submission of bids.
- 1.4.2 The technical and financial bid shall be placed in separate covers and superscribed as "Technical Bid" and "Financial Bid" as the case may be, along with the name of work and sealed. 1.6 OPENING OF TENDER:

1.6.1 On the day of opening of the tender, the financial bids of all the tenderers who submitted their bid, shall be placed in a separate cover and sealed in the presence of Tenderers who participate in the Tender opening. The financial bid of the Tenderers whose Technical offers have been accepted, alone will be opened at a later date under intimation to the successful qualified bidders and also after hosting in the website. The financial bids of the non-qualified bidders in Technical evaluation shall be returned unopened.

- **1.6.2** The individuals attending the opening of tenders should have a duly authorized by the participating firms in the tender.

COMMERCIAL AND TECHNICAL CONDITIONS

2.1 GENERAL

The scope of services shall be as detailed in Section-III.

2.2 LOCATION

South Indian Coastal States of Tamil Nadu, Kerala and the Union Territory of Puducherry

2.3 COMPLETENESS OF TENDER

The tender shall be complete in all aspects. The Bidders shall furnish all relevant details called for in this document and also attach supporting documents wherever required either in original or duly notarized for consideration by the tender inviting authority or their authorized representatives. The tenders bids not containing the complete details as required are liable for rejection.

2.4 SUBMISSION OF TENDER

Tenderers are advised to post their tenders bids well in advance so as to reach this office in time. Tenders though posted in time but delayed in transit by post will not be considered, if received after the due date and time.

2.5 PRICE

Tenderer shall quote FIRM Price only. For pricing structure kindly see the Annexure-I. Unit rates for individual items and Taxes should be quoted separately. Total price of the work shall also be filled in at the appropriate place.

2.6 VALIDITY OF TENDER

The tenders should be valid for a period of 90 days (ninety days) from the date of opening of tender. In case any bidder quotes a lower validity period than that specified, their offer shall be liable for rejection. In exceptional circumstances, the purchaser may solicit the bidder's consent for an extension of the period of validity. The request and response thereto shall be made in writing (including mail).

2.7 EMPLOYER RESERVES THE RIGHT

- a) Not to accept the lowest or any tender.
- b) To reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reasons thereof.
- c) To relax or waive any of the conditions stipulated in the tender specification as deemed necessary in the best interest of the project for good and sufficient reasons.
- d) To revise the quantum of works/completion period of work of any or all the items covered by this enquiry during the pendency of contract and to terminate the contract in between the agreed stipulated period.

2.8 EVALUATION AND COMPARISON OF TENDER OFFERS

- a) The evaluation of the Tender will be done as per IIT Madras guidelines in vogue.
- b) The evaluation shall include contract value of works with applicable sales/service tax, etc.,
- c) In case of discrepancy between the prices quoted in words and in figures, the lower of the two shall be considered.

2.9 PERFORMANCE BANK GUARANTEE:

The successful bidder shall submit performance Bank guarantee for an amount toRs.1,00,000/- (One Lakhs). The performance bank guarantee shall be furnished as per the format attached.

In case the successful bidder wishes to submit Bank Guarantee (BG) towards performance obligations viz. Performance Bank Guarantee, the BG should be routed through Beneficiary bank to the end user bank. The Bank Guarantee should remain valid for a period of sixty (60) days beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations of the contractor.

ONLY AFTER SUBMISSION OF PERFORMANE SECURITY, THE CONTRACT AGREEMENT SHALL BE EXECUTED AND ANY PAYMENT UNDER THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE RELEASED.

2.10 PAYMENT TERMS

- a) The Contractor can submit the bills for payment every month for the work they have completed during the preceding months.
- b) The bills will be passed for payment subject to the compliance of the bill and payment shall be released normally within 15 days of submission of bills.
- 2.10.1 Payment will be made either in the form of NEFT/RTGS transfer or by cheque on any of the commercial banks or their branches in India as may be decided by CMIS from time to time. If the contractor requests for Payment by DD, Exchange commission for issue of bank draft shall be to the account of the contractor.
- 2.10.2 Offers agreeing to the above terms of payment alone will be preferred. In the event of any deviation from the specified payment terms, the Authority/CMIS may reject the offers.

2.11 SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

2.11.1 PRE QUALIFICATION CRITERIA:

The prospective bidder should have carried out similar work for duration of minimum 1 year during the past three (3) years. Work orders pertaining to the same shall be provided as proof and enclosed in the technical bid. The prospective bidder should have any one boat (with valid registration in any on state, Tamil Nadu, Kerala & Puducherry) on his own. Attach the copy of the boat registration certificate, sea sailing/going license.

NOTE:

- a. Relevant work orders/agreement along with the work completion certificate issued by the competent authorities shall be enclosed either in original or notarized as proof of evidence of experience.
- b. Any two works of the followings five tasks would have been successfully carried out and completed by the bidder and the proof must be attached.
 - 1.Deployment of any Oceanographic Equipment upto-25m water depth
 - 2.Retrieval of Oceanographic Equipment from -25m water depth
 - 3. Samplings (Seabed Sediments & Seawater Samplings upto-25m water depth)
 - 4. Surveying (by Fixing the Single-Beam and/or Multi-Beam Echo-Sounder for bathymetry survey)

5.Surveillance (Watch Keepings for Safety of Seabed fixed and/or boat fixed equipment for continuous 48hrs)

- 2.11.2 It is also mandatory that the bidder should have supplied boats to any one port related works.
- 2.11.3 The required Boat Type (Service) by the CMIS, DOE, IITM shall be mobilized and commissioned by the successful bidder within three (3) days from the date of receipt of the comments as per CMIS, DOE, IITM instructions by mail/SMS. The contractor shall assist CMIS to fix the survey equipment and others in the boat and provide necessary watch and ward during the transportation and if necessary during the nights at their contractor cost for the safety of the CMIS, DOE, IITM equipment.

2.12 FORCE MAJEURE

Neither the Contractor nor the CMIS, DOE, IITM shall be considered in default in performance of its obligations hereunder if such performance is prevented or delayed for any causes beyond the reasonable control of the party affected, such as war, hostilities, revolution, riot, civil commotion, epidemic, major fires, explosions, floods, earthquakes and cyclones or because of any law, order, proclamatory regulations or ordinance of Government or because of any act of God, provided notice in writing of such cause with necessary evidence that the obligation under the Contract is thereby affected or prevented or delayed, is given within 14 days from the happening of the event and in any case it is not possible to serve the notice within 14 days period, then within the shortest possible period without delay. In case the force majeure conditions prolong beyond a continuous period of 6 months, the CMIS, DOE, IITM shall be entitled to decide the further course of action including revisions in the terms of Contract, if any.

- 2.12.1 As soon as the cause of Force Majeure has been removed, the party whose ability to perform its obligation has been affected shall notify the other party the actual delay occurred on account of such activities with authorized evidence/proof in writing.
- 2.12.2 Although the time for completion of work shall be suitably extended (not exceeding the period during which the work was stopped on account of Force Majeure clause), such extension shall not result in any financial claim by the Contractor against the Purchaser or any account of such a delay for any other reason whatsoever.

2.13 TAXES

The price quoted shall be firm and shall be inclusive of fuel, skilled/unskilled manpower for maneuvering the Boats and also excluding other consumable Taxes and/or GST. GST is as applicable and shall be indicated which shall be either paid by CMIS, DOE, IITM directly or reimbursed at actual to the successful bidder/Contractor. Necessary income tax will be deducted at source on each bill as per the regulations in force and TDS will be issued. If the Boat supplier is exempted from payment of income tax, the documentary evidence for the same has to be furnished.

2.14 LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:-

If the contractors fails to supply the suitable boats within the specified time, or fail to replace the repaired / damaged boats, within the period specified by the CMIS, DOE, IITM and / or the contractor deserted the work or delayed the work for reasons solely attributable to them, the CMIS, DOE, IITM shall levy the liquidated damage (not by way of penalty) at the rate of 0.5% of the total contract value per week or part thereof subject to maximum of 10% of overall contract value. If the work has been abandoned or quality of the boat supplied is not upto the satisfaction of the CMIS. DOE, IITM, the CMIS, DOE, IITM shall also reserve its rights to terminate the contract after giving 10 days' notice, in addition of levying the Liquidated damage and forfeiting the performance Bank Guarantee. The decision of the CMIS in this regard is final and binding on the contractor.

2.15 JURISDICTION FOR LEGAL PROCEEDINGS

No suit or any proceedings in regard to any matter arising in any respect under this contract shall be instituted in a Court Save in the City Civil Court of Chennai or the Courts of Small Causes at Chennai. It is agreed that no other courts shall have jurisdiction to entertain any suit or proceedings even though part of the cause of action might arise within their jurisdiction. In case any part of cause of action arises within the jurisdiction of any of the courts in Tamil Nadu and not in the courts in the Chennai City, it is agreed to between the parties that such suits or proceedings shall be instituted in a court within Tamil Nadu and no other court outside Tamil Nadu shall have jurisdiction, even though any part of the cause of action might arise within the jurisdiction of such courts.

The bidders shall furnish an undertaking in a non-judicial stamp paper of value Rs.100/- agreeing to the <u>above condition</u> as per schedule furnished in Annexure-II. This should be given after issuing the work order – This is applicable for selected L1 bidder.

2.16 ARBITRATION

Arbitration is not applicable to this contract.

2.17 COMPLETION OF PROJECT

Time duration of completion of project is twelve (12) calendar months from the date of acceptance of work order. However, CMIS, DOE, IITM reserves its rights to vary the contract period for six months (viz \pm 6 months) under the same terms and conditions of the agreement without any entitlement of the revision of the rates. All the payments process of short term and or long term completions will be made only after getting the confirmation from the boat representative and CMIS,DOE, IITM representative on the operations & executions as actuals. The final completion of project command to the Contractor will be given only by the CMIS, DOE, IITM office representative by letter and or mail.

2.18 ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

The tenderers is deemed to have been accepted all the terms and conditions of this tender including.

- 1. Specific acceptance of terms of payment.
- 2. Terms of Liquidated damages for delay in completion of work.
- 3. Validity of tender.

If no indication is given by the tenderer in his offer, it is presumed that the tenderer is agreeable to the terms and conditions of the CMIS mentioned in this tender.

SPECIFICATIONS

Bids are invited for providing the following services on daily rate basis for CMIS program of DOE at IIT Madras. Successful bidder will be engaged to provide the boat services and will be known as "CONTRACTOR". The near shore and offshore field measurement program for implementation of CMIS for Central Water Commission (CWC), Ministry of Water Resources (MoWR), Govt, of India by DOE of IIT Madras involves field measurement campaigns along South West (SW) &South East (SE) coast of India. This program requires different types of services and boats. The boats will be operated within -25m depth contours (approximately 5km to 10km distance perpendicular to the normal shoreline). The services involve the following items, but not exhaustive.

TYPE -1	Boat services for the Deployment and Retrieval of equipment within 0m to-25m water depth including transportation& Manpower

Special Conditions:

- (i) Oceanographic / Survey equipment that need to be deployed will be supplied by IIT Madras.
- (ii) For **TYPE-1** activity, the bidder shall use boats of suitable size with capability to operate up to -25m water depth. The boat shall have a mechanical motorized winch with capacity to lifting and lowering minimum 1000kg weight within 0m to -25m water depths. Boat should have the suitable navigational, safety and communication equipment including sounding equipment with display for the purpose of understanding sailing ground depths. The boats shall be motorized. Seagoing license or other approval required for the said use is the responsibility of the Contractor.
- (iii) For **TYPE-2** activity, the contractor shall supply boats of suitable size with capability to operate from shore to -25m water depth. Boat equipped with working suitable navigational, safety and communication equipment including sounding equipment with display for the purpose of understanding sailing ground depths &also mechanical motorized winch which can operate from 0m to -25m water depths. The boats shall be motorized. Seagoing license or other approval required for the said use is the responsibility of the Contractor.
- (iv) For **TYPE-3** activity, it is the responsibility of the Contractor to perform Surveillances/Watch Keepings of the deployed and/or fixed equipment with minimum one boat & manpower along with the safety measures. The boat shall have capability to operate up to -25m water depth. The boat shall be self-motorized or use outboard motor. Seagoing license or other approval required for the said use is the responsibility of the Contractor.
- (v) For **TYPE-4** activity, it is the responsibility of the Contractor to perform Surveillances/Watch Keepings, beach landing, transportation of the equipment from the shore to the survey vessels, manpower transportation to the survey vessels, movements, supply of food, groceries to the Type 3 boats, etc along with the safety measures is the responsibility of the Contractor. The boat shall have capability to operate up to -25m water depth. The boat shall be self-motorized or use outboard motor. Seagoing license or other approval required for the said use is the responsibility of the Contractor.
- (vi) The safety of the CMIS, DOE, IITM equipment of seabed mounted along with the surface markings, and equipment fixed within the boat like echo-sounder, DGPS, MRU, surveying, etc under Surveillances is the responsibility of the Boat contractor.
 - In a case of any loss of equipment it is the responsibility of the boat contractor. Further, intimation to the nearest coastal village, local police, coastal communities, search operations and other relevant necessary retrievals, search and findings operations are the sole responsibility of the Boat Contractor. IITM will provide assist as and when required.

- (vii) All insurance coverage for the boat and its manpower / services resources are the responsibilities of the contractor.
- (viii) Availability / engagement of suitable support crafts one or two to assist the above services is the responsibility of the boat bidder / contractor.
- (ix) Contractor need not engage minimum special manpower like, skipper, driver, fireman, boat operator, crew, captain, helmsman, etc for the purpose of providing the services under all the activities with his own cost.IIT Madras will provide the special, technical manpower for the operations of the supplied equipment. However, the contractor shall provide required minimum manpower to carry out the various activities in sea/marine/ocean/river and shore, ports, etc.

For **TYPE - 1** activities, the skilled manpower for the deployment and retrieval is the responsibility of the contractor. Including mooring, transportation of the equipment to the deployment site including manpower.

For **TYPE - 2** activities, the skilled manpower for the bathymetry surveying, boat running in the straight survey lines as required is the responsibility of the boat contractor. Mobilization and De-mobilization charges will be paid from the shortest and nearest location as decided by the CMIS, DOE, IITM will be paid. The Seabed and Seawater samplings at different depths for the operating of Grab Samplers and Niskin Water Samplers by winch are the responsibility of the Boat Crews as directed by the CMIS, DOE, IITM.

For **TYPE - 3** and **TYPE - 4** boats, the entire responsibility is with the Boat Contractor as required by the CMIS, DOE, IITM as and when required.

The contractor is required to mobilize the supply of the specific type of boats and carryout the activity successfully as and when required for the operations of oceanographic measurements/data collections either short and or longer period. A detailed tentative program will be handed over to the successful contractor by DOE, IITM minimum three (3) to four (4) days in advance. The approximate number of days of operations in one year the services are required to be provided at each site will differ and may change. The work will be in three South Indian States (1.Tamil Nadu, 2. Kerala & 3. Pondicherry). In Tamil Nadu, the working coastal stretch will be near to Mahabalipuram including Chennai & Kanchipuram Districts. In Pondicherry, the working coastal stretch will be in and around Karaikal. In Kerala, the working coastal stretch will be in and around Pudu-Ponnani. Deployments, Retrieval, Surveying Samplings, Surveillances and others will be from the shore to the offshore. i.e Shallow Water (0m depth contour) to Deep Waters (-25m depth contour). Instruments deployed either in Single Mooring and "U" type mooring or both at minimum one (1) or two (2) different locations at different water depths. The type of mooring will be dictated by CMIS, DOE, IITM and will be prepared and executed by the Boat Contractor. No payment will be made on the IMD weather warning (Cyclone Warnings, Tsunami, Rough Weather, High Waves, etc) days, due to unforeseen situations. The written proof of the non-surveillance and withdraw from the watch keeping must be given before withdraw from the site, else contractor full responsibility, if any loss. - As the items of the BOQ (Annexure II) are independent and they cannot be considered in isolation, the award of contract will be made by the work in totality. (i.e Total value of all the work will be taken together for selecting the lowest bidder).
- The total value of contracts which can be awarded to the successful bidder/contractor in stages during the Twelve (12) Months or within the Eighteen (18) Month period shall be limited to Rs.1,60,00,000/- (Rupees One Crore and Sixty Lakhs Only) including GST.
